(windows) → Counter-Strike Global Offensive is a free online first-person shooter video game. You play as one of six available classes, of which the most well-known is the assault class. Counter-Strike: Global Offensive is an online First Person Shooter by Valve, creators of Half-Life and Portal. With over 130 million players worldwide, it is the most popular competitive FPS of all time and a mainstay of the PC gaming scene, as well as a critical commercial success. We know from previously published reports on the Steam hardware survey that the game has been a considerable success on Linux, as well as being a Steam Greenlight project. Counter-Strike: Global Offensive was released on June 26, 2012, for Microsoft Windows, OS X, and Linux. The same day, the source code of the game was released under the GPL version 3. There are numerous languages available for the game such as English, French, Spanish, German, Russian, Polish, Portuguese, Czech, Turkish, Italian, Chinese, Brazilian Portuguese, Hungarian, and Romanian, and over 150 language translations of the in-game items and user interface. The server population for Counter-Strike: Global Offensive includes 1.5 million players worldwide. This is an increase of over 70,000 players from June 2012. The game enjoys one of the highest player numbers of any game on the Steam gaming platform. Like previous versions, CS:GO has been released for free and there is no paid version of the game. With the release of the game, there was a massive surge in popularity, which saw the game selling 2 million units in its first 24 hours. Since then, there have been various server and gameplay tweaks done to the game. The game was also released for OS X on August 22, 2012 and for Steam OS on November 9, 2015, making the game available for iOS and Android users. On August 6, 2018, Valve announced that it would be bringing CS:GO to its own platform, the Steam Machine. The game was released for Linux in 2019, and is currently the first and only game of the series to release on Linux.
